Olympic National Park in the state of Washington has some of the most scenic beaches in the world and Rialto Beach is one of the best. It had been raining for two (2) days and the storm system finally began to dissipate. I'd hoped for a nice sunset and wasn't disappointed.

When arriving at Rialto Beach, I forged over a mass of old logs and driftwood piled at least 10 feet high in some places resulting from years of logging long ago. As I approached the actual dark sand and pebble beach and looked to the right, I saw many beautiful sea stacks in the distance. They didn't seem far, but I found that it took about 1½ hours to reach them. I had to cross a fairly wide stream that flowed into the sea. Those downed logs and driftwood allowed me to make

the crossing; however, it was still tricky carrying my tripod and other equipment.

I made sure I was aware of low and high tide so not to get trapped from returning. I spent at least three (3) hours at this very spot on the beach and the sunset was spectacular. The tide was rising fast and it was near dark when I packed to return. Since I was photographing in late evening, I made sure to have a headlamp. Crossing the stream mentioned earlier was even trickier in the dark. I returned safely and couldn't wait to see the results. Again, I wasn't disappointed.

Featured Photograph No. 2 below of Second Beach also in Olympic National Park is one of my favorite beach photographs. I photographed this beach the next evening, and once again, I was blessed with a beautiful sunset.
